Next year at Lon Morris new and exciting things are on the horizon! Our school is growing and expanding its programs, and that means we are expanding our enrollment. We anticipate our resident population to more than double next year which has allowed us to change the concept of Residence Life here at LMC!

New for next year:

- I. Co-Ed Housing! = You have requested it and the new numbers for enrollment have made it possible! We are offering Co-Ed housing in Fair Hall, Brown Hall, and the new COOPER HOUSE! We will still maintain Clark Hall as all male and Craven-Wilson as an all female hall. College is about variety and Campus Housing should be no different, and we are just getting started!
- II. Off-Campus Housing! = Due to the large number of incoming Freshmen, LMC will not be able to house all students. This opens up a new concept in Lon Morris history, the chance to live off-campus! Living off-campus means more freedom and flexibility in your college education. Just fill out your application to live off campus with the Campus Life Office and you will be free to find housing here in town!
- III. Cooper House!! = You have seen the construction crews working and by Fall 2009 the Cooper House will be open! This new residence hall will house 32 students selected by committee. Fill out an intent to live in Cooper Application, and your name goes into consideration for living in the first new residence hall built on LMC campus since 1969! This opportunity is for Sophomores only, who have good residence life history.

Lon Morris College expects to have limited On-campus Housing available in Fall, 09 and Spring, 10 due to increased enrollment. Housing will be administered on a "first-come, first served" basis. To reserve your On-Campus room, this form must be completed and on file in the Campus Life Office along with your room reservation fee no later than 5:00 pm on May 9, 2009. The receipt date and time of your application and fee will be used to determine priority for On-Campus housing; therefore, make every effort to submit your application and fee promptly. Preferences will be considered, but all rooms will be assigned by availability.
